

Research on the Reform Path of University Teaching Model under the Background of MOOCs

1. Introduction

And there are many kinds of courses, learners can choose different courses according to their own needs, or even choose different teachers. Basically, the corresponding teaching video of courses that cannot learn in school or some extra-curricular interest courses can be found in MOOCs and students can begin selflearning by MOOCs. In learning, if you encounter problems, you can also directly communicate with other students who are also learning this course, to solve the problems. If you cannot solve problems by communicating with your classmates, you can also directly communicate with the teachers who teach this course. And MOOCs are very cheap. Only with a mobile phone, or a computer connected to the Internet, one can start his learning at anytime and anywhere, which also provides a good learning platform for most of the learners without economic ability.

3.2. Advantages and disadvantages of modern university teaching mode

Modern university teaching mode makes full use of the achievements of science and technology, maximizing the value of teacher resources and students' creativity. Today, with the full development of the Internet, the online teaching mode, MOOCs, is basically adopted to realize the exchange of teacher resources. And the one-to-one teaching method will give learners more motivation to learn; secondly, on the virtual network platform such as MOOCs, most of the students choose learning courses spontaneously according to their own interests or needs. The existence of teachers is mainly for answering questions and solving puzzles. This teaching mode enables students to have more choices and greater initiative; finally, the virtual network curriculum platform of MOOCs is full of randomness and contingency. People who study this course may have different age levels, different social identities, and different life experiences, which leads to their different knowledge mastery and different ways of thinking. The collision of thinking during communication in the course will enable them to have more and deeper understanding of the knowledge they have learned. But even if MOOCs have so many advantages, we still have to recognize that the traditional university education mode is irreplaceable. In MOOCs, students learn a little by a little during a long. Therefore, after they finish all the courses, they may still don't remember anything, and they don't realize the problems by themselves. In the contemporary university teaching mode, traditional classroom teaching should still be taken as the main teaching mode to train professional talents. As the same time, MOOCs should be taken as a supplementary teaching method to provide the basis of learning a variety of knowledge for those who love learning [5].

With the development of the times, the teaching mode of universities will certainly change to adapt to the development of the times and social changes. However, no matter how the university teaching mode changes, whether it is the traditional teacher-led classroom, the modern teacher-student-led classroom, or the MOOCs, the original intention of university education is not only to teach knowledge, but also to cultivate a group of young people with independent thinking ability, divergent thinking ability, good mentality, good communicative ability and the ability to adapt to social development and make contribution to the progress of society.

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
